Reason for Request							
<p>This request covers a number of proposed changes in the Harnomised BaseLine V2.1 to reflect design outcomes from the ESB Newtorks Harmonisation Project.</p> <p>The items include the proposed removal of the 501, 504 and 505 message definitions from the schema as these old ROI Message are no longer used since the introduction of the SEM arrangements. ROI will not offer resends of these messages and NI will not use them. Some code values are proposed for removal as they will not be used in either jurisdiction following Harmonisation.</p> <p>Also, several coded values are now no longer to be used in either jurisdiction and these have been removed from the Harmonised BaseLine as described below.</p> <p>Also, several business definitions were found to be lacking in completeness and these have been replaced as described below.</p>
