Detail of Request								
Reason for Request								
Approved MCR 1055 included the removal of the non-billable keypad meter totaliser register type from the Enduring Solution. This DR is to align with the enduring solution and remove the totaliser register from the interim solution. This will allow scheduled readings for keypad meters, currently being collected by NIE meter readers via hand held units in advance of enduring solution go-live (May 2012), to be stored in CC&B. These readings will be used: - for monthly DuoS billing, instead of vend history, - for settlement and EAC, AAC updates.								
Proposed Solution								
This change request is to remove the non-billable keypad meter totaliser register from the Interim Solution. It is proposed: - that the CC&B interface program which currently raises an exception when the number of registers received does not match the number of registers configured will be changed to enable normal processing when Suppliers do not provide readings for the keypad meter totaliser register eg the Supplier sends readings for 4 registers (on a keypad meter), but NIE holds a 5 register keypad meter configuration in CC&B, - that the user-exit programs in CC&B are amended so that outbound market messages (N300 series) do not contain readings for totaliser registers. It should be noted that existing CC&B keypad meter configurations will remain unchanged, as any change to the configuration could prove problematic for historic keypad meter data. This DR assumes that Suppliers must amend their keypad meter configurations to remove the non-billable keypad meter totaliser register.
