<b>Detail of Request</b>			
<b>Reason for Request</b>			
The Enduring Solution process in NI requires that the customer contacts their Supplier to submit an 030 market message where the increased/decreased connection process involves a change to MCC. This Discussion Request proposes that NIE will align with the ESB/RoI process and no longer require an 030 market message from the Supplier for MCC changes associated with an increase/decrease MIC change.			
<b>Proposed Solution</b>			
When NIE generate a quotation for the increased/decreased supply, the Supplier will receive a 301N market message to notify them of the relevant proposed characteristic changes. NIE will progress with the construction and any necessary metering changes and the Supplier will receive the 301 market message (and 331/332) on completion of the work. NIE's quotation letter will include a clause stressing the importance of the customer making contact with their Supplier to discuss the proposed changes. On receipt of the 301N, if the Supplier has an issue with the proposed changes they must contact the customer to discuss and resolve (e.g. ask them to either cancel the job or change to a Supplier who can support their proposed change). NIE will not cancel or delay the completion of any related metering work if the Supplier contacts them with concerns about the proposed changes. There are no changes to the market message schema for Northern Ireland or the Harmonised Schema.
