Detail of Discussion Request	
<p>A number of changes are required to the CoS objection & cancellation process.</p> <p>Cancellation MPD The process flow following the decision diamond after Step 5 (CoS Incomplete or open objection) needs to be made more explicit and the text associated with it should be expanded to cater for the four differing scenarios which can occur in this context.</p> <p>The 4 scenarios are;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open objection with COS complete 2. Open objection with COS incomplete 3. No open objection with COS complete 4. No open objection with COS incomplete <p>In particular Step 15 we now informed can occur where an open objection exists and COS is complete and also where it is incomplete. Consequently step 15 needs to be expanded to show how in the case of COS being completed the old supplier becomes reinstated (i.e. customer re-registered to them), readings are withdrawn/ replaced etc and any meter works reversed. Additionally suppliers are informed through message 111 that the COS is being cancelled – it needs to be clarified whether this 111 will be different in case of COS complete/ incomplete. Any special reason codes associated with the messages in these scenarios need to be identified.</p> <p>Objection MPD</p> <p>The process flow following the decision diamond after Step 4 needs to be made explicit. We have been informed that if COS is complete the process goes to step 9. The process flow needs to identified to show if the COS is complete what happens and to account for the new supplier deciding whether or not to cancel COS.</p>
