Detail of Discussion Request	
<p>In MPD 15 page 7 it has the following two sentences in bold below :</p> <p><b>When QH data is replaced this will be confirmed by MRSO to the Supplier (and/or Generator in the case of export) and Transmission System Operator via email and /or telephone on the day messages are intended to be re-sent. Any aggregation performed using the original data will be reversed and any new data re-aggregated.</b></p> <p>The first sentence is not entirely accurate. MRSO send a notification to the supplier on the next working day after the replacement data has been sent. Therefore a more accurate sentence would be:</p> <p>"When QH data is replaced this will be confirmed by MRSO to the Supplier (and/or *Generator in the case of export) and Transmission System Operator via email and / or telephone on the next working day after the replacement data has been sent."</p> <p>The second sentence's wording: "Any aggregation performed using the original data will be reversed and any new data re-aggregated" is somewhat misleading. An aggregation run is never reversed. This sentence should read:</p> <p>"Original data used in Initial aggregation and previous re-aggregations will be replaced by the new data for the next re-aggregation."</p> <p>*In the case where a generator has nominated another market participant as the recipient of their messages then only the nominated recipient of the Generator's market messages will receive notification of replacement QH data being sent from ESB Networks.</p>
