Messages passed to the MPCC with a filename of less than 7 characters (excluding the .xml extension) are failing during processing as one of the first steps taken by the MPCC is to check if the first 7 characters are of a particular value. If this step determines that the filename is less than 7 characters this generates an error, although the file may be perfectly valid.
