When a site is de-registered, ESB Networks carry out a final billing of the site, causing a 300 message to issue to the de-registering supplier following the issue of the 122 message.

This 300 message is not part of the design (it is not included on MPD 21) and should be suppressed by ESB Networks.

At present, Suppliers must process messages which are not included on the MPD, causing significant overhead and manual intervention.
