Each of the market messages contains a field called Message Type in the header. Message 114 contains a second field called 'Message Type' (to indicate whether the message is a response or an advice). It is proposed to rename this field to 'Message Status' in line with the XML schema and to avoid confusion as these fields are used in two completely different contexts with different valid values and field sizes.
