Part 1: Detail of Defect & Proposal

MPD 19 -Terminate connection currently indicates that if a site which is currently registered to a Supplier has been terminated (expected to occur in exceptional circumstances only) then MRSO would initiate de-registration without any contact from the Supplier.

Testing has indicated that this is not possible. Instead it is proposed that a manual intervention is required from both MRSO & Supplier for de-registration to progress. Prior to termination MRSO will manually contact the Supplier and request that they submit a de-registration (021 message) to MRSO.

A de-registration confirmation (122 message) for the MPRN must issue before DSO can effect termination
