Detail of Change Request

Background

This MCR concerns non participant generator sites where import and export are registered to different suppliers.

A 331 message issues to suppliers who are registered for import at a QH MPRN. This 331 message contains the meter details of the meter that is sent on the 341. Currently, when a supplier registers to buy the export from a specific non-participant generator, they do not receive a 331. The receipt of a 331 message would aid specific suppliers in the creation of meter/MPRN data on their systems.

Proposed Solution

The supplier who is registering the export arrangement for a particular non participant generator can request the receipt of the meter details at the MPRN via a 331 message. This 331 message can be requested using either of two methods:

1. Via Form 2 (Working Practice 14), that is, at the initial registration of the supplier to the non-participant generator
2. Via email, that is, the supplier must already be the registered supplier for the non-participant generator. The email request must contain the following as a minimum:
 - Supplier
 - Supplier Unit
 - MPRN
 - EARN

The proposed solution is outlined in the following graphic:

Notes on Proposed Solution	
<p>Under this solution, any or all suppliers registered for export from a non-participant generator may request receipt of a 331 message.</p> <p>Working Practice 14 (Distribution Connected Non Participant Generator Export Arrangements) will be updated in line with this MCR to allow suppliers to register their interest in receiving an initial 331 message in respect of the site. Subsequently, registered suppliers will need to request any updates to the metering details via email (in the format above) to MRSO.</p> <p>Provided that the requests pass MRSO's validation checks, then MRSO will create, verify and send a 331 message to the requesting export supplier. The meter details that will be sent in the 331 message will be the details of the meter contained in the 342 message for the particular EARN in the request.</p>	
Reason for Change Request	
Suppliers have to manually gather meter data/MPRN for the cases where they receive export only from a non-participant generator, that is, they are not the registered supplier for import at a site. This manual process is seen to be time consuming and suppliers would prefer an automated process.
