**Detail of Request**  
**Reason for Request**

This Change Request proposes to disable (at least until a post go live review is carried out) the functionality and processes where a Supplier may request a non-visit keypad configuration change. Initially all keypad meter configuration change requests by Suppliers will be carried out on site by NIE.

This is to ensure that the change of meter configuration process for keypad meters is carried out with accuracy and precision and also to ensure the integrity of data provided by NIE for DUoS billing and settlements.

**Proposed Solution**

Initially all keypad meter configuration change requests by Suppliers will require a site visit by NIE. The Meter Works Type "K01 - Change Keypad Meter Configuration - No Site Visit Required" will be developed as part of the enduring solution but disabled until it is clear what types of keypad meters can be correctly reconfigured remotely.

NIE will collect data on different types of keypad meters and provide the UR with recommendations that will be used for the post go live review. The review will take into account:

- Estimated Savings that will be accrued by remotely reconfiguring keypad meters;
- The additional issues and risks that will be encountered by remote reconfiguration to the quality of market data; and
- The change in the customer experience.
