Reason for Request							
<p><u>Changes from DR 1084:</u> Process Flow had few corrections Templates were updated</p> <p>The unmetred market has grown significantly since Market Opening in 2005. At the outset of market opening, ESB Electric Ireland (Formerly ESB Customer Supply) was the only Market Participant with unmetred sites registered to them. Increasingly, other MPs have entered the unmetred market necessitating more regular use and review of the unmetred process documentation. It became evident that the process documentation needed improvement and realignment with the actual operational execution of the processes.</p> <p>It has been identified by various stakeholders within the unmetred arena, that the unmetred processes need technical and system improvements. Proposed Solution							
<p>It became evident through analysis of process, business operation and meeting with relevant business units, that MPD 36 dealt with 2 separate processes. The process differed significantly if a Change of supply was required versus no change of supplier required. The changes to be implemented include:</p> <p>MPD 36 1.1 - Change of Group MPRN_COS Process Flow: MPD 36.1.1 - see attached document. The flow has changed quite considerably. The correct parties for all steps of process are identified as are steps and links to relevant templates.</p> <p>Business Changes: * MRSO will execute all change to Grouped MPRNs where a CoS is required * New Supplier to be contact point for all processing. All communication between end customers (old and new) and suppliers (old and new) will take place outside of this process and is outside MRSO/ESB Networks remit. * Ensure all change to Grouped MPRNs (even if a single T-MPRN is moving to a new G-MPRN of a new supplier) follow this process and do not get treated as a COLE.</p>
