Detail of Change Request

Ver 4.1 of the Message Data Structures defines 'Title' as a CHAR (4) field with no defined list of allowable codes. It is proposed to define the following set of allowable codes for the 'Title' field.

- Ms
- Mr
- Miss
- Mrs
- Dr
- Prof
- Sr
- Fr
- Br
- Rev

The above list represents 99% of ESB Customer Supply customer. This proposed set of codes would appear on the relevant Webforms.

Where market participants do not provide a valid code the market message will not be rejected – but rather the Title will be converted to blanks. This will have no impact on the title format used by Suppliers in communication with their customers. However it may mean that in the small percentage of cases not covered by the proposed list of codes that ESB Networks communication with the effected customers will include a blank title

Also as 'Title' is an optional field participants are free to leave the field blank

Reason for Change Request

Market systems software requires 'Title' to be stored as a codified field
