Detail of Request													
Reason for Request													
<p>This Discussion Request proposes that the concept of implied energisation be removed from the 030 market message. The harmonised 030 Market Message Implementation guide states that "A request for a change of meter configuration for a site that is currently de-energised will be taken as an implicit request for energisation and will be accepted as long as there is a supply agreement in existence." There is an issue with this approach as the 030 does not have a Customer Name field, or a CoLE field, so NIE would be re-energising the premise without a new customer name. For this reason, NIE propose to remove the implied energisation and insist upon a 017 to request re-energisation (as it includes customer details and CoLE fields).</p> <p>In tandem with the implied energisation, the harmonised 030 Market Message Implementation guide also states that "Alternatively a Supplier may submit both an 017 Meter Point Status Change Request and an 030 Meter Works Request. In this scenario a single appointment should be booked and the same appointment id included on the 017 and 030 messages." The complexity of design for the Supplier appointment booking facility on the market website does not allow two market messages to contain the same appointment ID, so NIE are proposing to remove this option from the market.</p>													
Proposed Solution													
<p>NIE propose removing the concept of implied energisation from the 030 market message. A request for a change of meter configuration for a site that is currently de-energised will not be taken as an implicit request for energisation and will be rejected. The Supplier must submit a 017 market message to request re-energisation. The Supplier then has two options for the meter works request:</p> <p>[1] Wait for the re-energisation to complete, and submit a 030 market message for the meter works. This results in two fieldwork visits.</p> <p>[2] After submission of the 017, contact NIE by telephone to agree the metering requirements and to request that the meter works be carried out on the same fieldwork visit as the re-energisation. NIE will manually manage the fieldwork scheduling to ensure the re-energisation and meter works are performed in the one fieldwork visit.</p> <p>The following changes will be required to the validation rules for NI:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 017 Validation of Appointment ID: An 017 Meter Point Status Change Request and 030 Meter Works Request may not contain the same Appointment ID, as a single appointment may not be booked for a change of meter configuration and energisation of a de-energised site - 030 Validation of Appointment ID: An 017 Meter Point Status Change Request and 030 Meter Works Request may not contain the same Appointment ID, as a single appointment may not be booked for a change of meter configuration and energisation of a de-energised site 030 - Validation of MPRN Status: If the MPRN status is 'D', the 030 will be rejected.
