Reason for Request				
<p>In June 2011 the Commission published a proposed Decision, CER/11/106 - Customer Bad Debt in Electricity & Gas Markets, on the issue of Customer Bad Debt. CER approved the implementation of a debt flagging facility into the Change of Supplier processes for both domestic and small/medium businesses in the electricity and gas markets.</p> <p>The CER further ruled on the key dates for implementation, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Interim Debt Flagging solution for implementation by 1st Oct 2011 - Automated Debt Flagging solution for implementation by 1st Jan 2013 (Please note, this date cannot be achieved as there is no Jan 2013 Market Release.) <p>As stated in the Decision paper, due to the significant amount of system change required to automate a new process and due to the existing commitment regarding the delivery of the Retail Market Harmonisation Project precluding development in 2011, an interim Working Practice was required to meet the October 1st deadline. RMDS, in conjunction with MRSO, has now initiated Working Practice 20 to serve as the interim solution to the approved debt flagging proposal within the Change of Supplier process.</p> <p>The interim solution is already in place. The Automated Debt Flagging Solution is due to be implemented in the October 2013 Market Release. Due to the manual working of Grouped Unmetered MPRNs, it is not possible to include Grouped Unmetered in the Automated Solution. Thus a new Working Practice has been created to allow a manual process to continue for Grouped Unmetered Debt Flagging</p>				
Proposed Solution				
<p>A new Working Practice has been created to allow a manual process to continue for Grouped Unmetered Debt Flagging. The current Working Practice 20 for the interim manual solution has timelines for users that differ to the timelines of the Automated Solution. This Working Practice 20 will therefore be retired at implementation of the Automated Solution and a new Working Practice 23 will begin which will cater for Grouped Unmetered Debt Flagging along the timelines of the Automated Solution i.e. 48 hour for each step in the process.</p> <p>Main changes from WP 20:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduction of new Email Templates to cater for Objection Rejection, Cancellation, Cancellation Rejection and Cancellation Notifications within the manual Group Unmetered CoS process • Amendment of MM110 Email Template to include a CoLE flag <p>Details are contained in the embedded Working Practice 23.</p>
