

- The Eircode Project is aiming to have 'Eircodes' available in Q2, 2015
- ESB Group have been asked to facilitate the Postcode Project
 - ESB Networks are the first step within the ESB Group in facilitating this process
- A Data Sharing Agreement is in place between the Eircode Project and ESB Group to allow data from the Central Market System be made available for Eircodes
- Once Eircodes have been allocated to sites these will be made available back to ESNB where data matching has been possible
- ESNB are working on a DR to determine what work needs to be done on Central Market System to allow the addition of the new postcode where available
 - Schema or non schema?
 - Field usage?
 - Market Messages impacted?
 - Etc?
- Suppliers / TSO will as normal need to assess the impact of the DR for themselves
 - Will a postcode cause problems if it comes across without supplier system changes?
 - How much work will be required to enable postcodes?
- Once an MCR is agreed then timelines for release – in 2015? – need to be agreed

Public Lighting Centrally Managed Systems



- **Local Authorities wish to implement new PL CMS systems in order to reduce costs**
- **The PL CMS systems allow individual lights to be dimmed, switched on/off, etc.**
- **From an ESN perspective this means public lighting is no longer predictable**
- **ESBN has looked at up to five different ways that the LA requirements could be met**
- **The ESN view is that a public consultation is required to determine which option suits the Market**
- **CER have been briefed**
- **There are no easy options**
