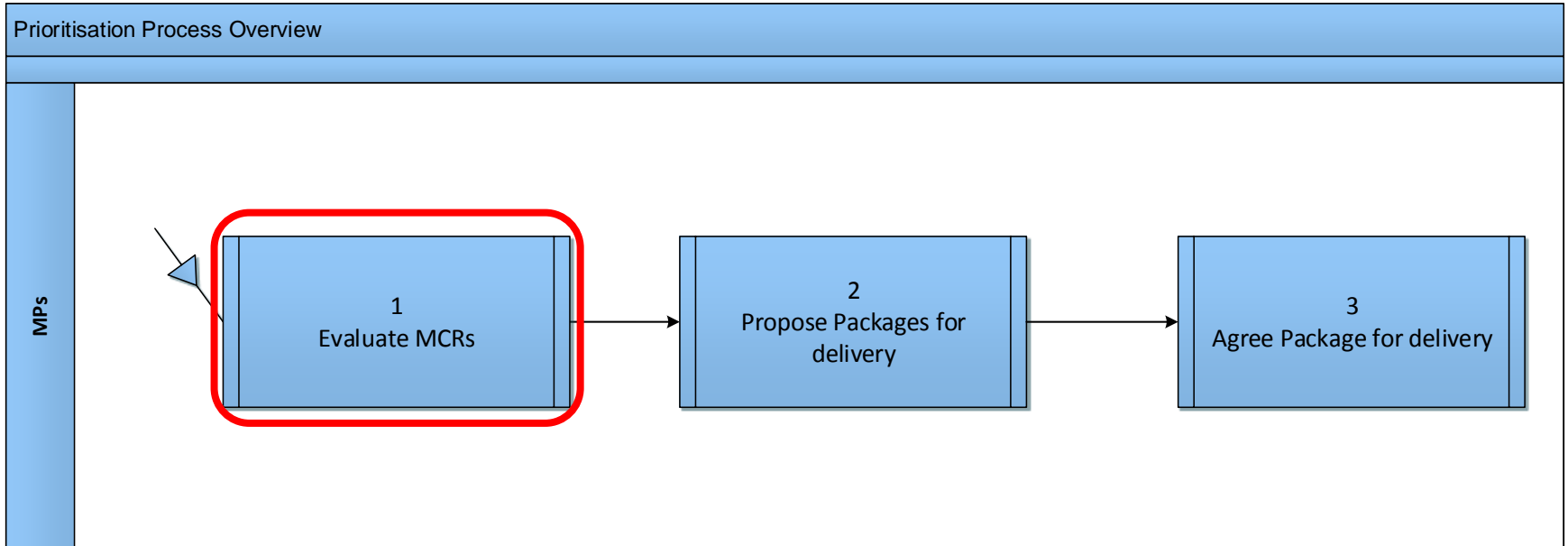

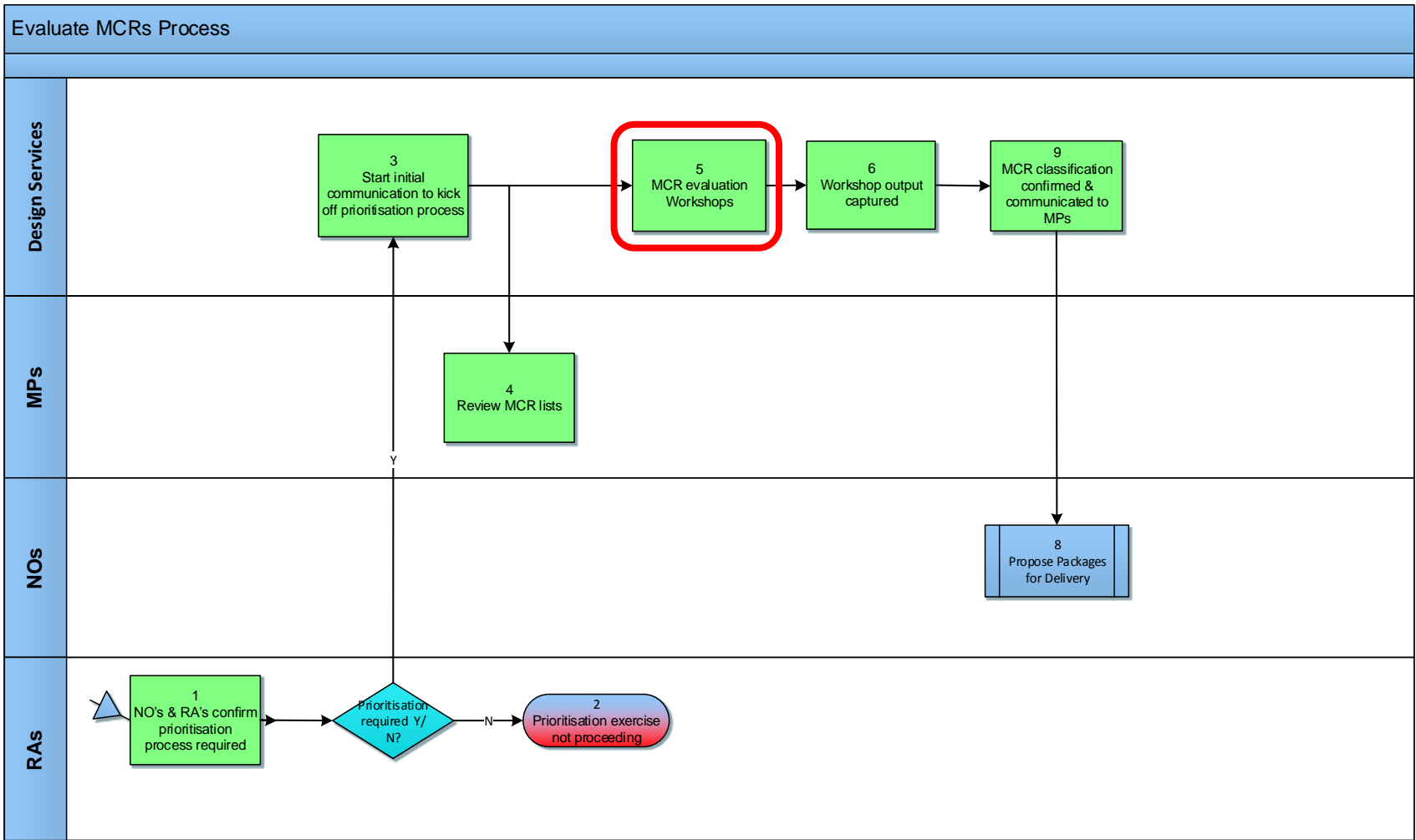

Objective for today

The objective of these workshops is to classify each MCR by consensus as:

- **Included for prioritisation**
 - Has a Significant improvement for all Suppliers and/or Network Operator(s) in terms of increased efficiency, reduced transaction time , reduced work effort and/or compliance. These will be brought forward for Network Operator Impact assessment.
- **Not included for prioritisation**
 - Is not immediately required as the market has functioned without its implementation to date satisfactorily without significant additional impact on MPs. These will not be brought forward for the Network Operator Impact assessment for this release but if a synergy is identified it may be included in a package option.
- **Withdrawn**
 - MPs agree that this MCR is to be assigned a permanent classification of "Withdrawn". If a similar requirement arises in the future a new DR shall have to be raised.

Change Summary	<p><i>The proposal is to change the current categorisation and assurance approach within the Small Supplier category and introduce a sub category (for assurance purposes) to the small Supplier Categorisation. The sub categorisation is based on the segments for qualification and the overall business model that the New Entrant intends following.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>* SS (1) Small number of large power use sites (generally QH) up to 200 MPRNs</i> <i>* SS (2) Large number of low power use sites (NQH) up to 200 MPRNs</i> <i>* SS (3) Combination of predominantly low power use sites and some few large power use sites (NQH and QH) up to 200MPRNs.</i> <p><i>The threshold of 10MW power supplied at peak demand will not apply as criteria for operating in the Retail Market in the Small Supplier category where a Supplier indicates that their business model is one which is a small number of customers but where there will be greater than 10MW power at peak demand.</i></p>		
Notes	<p>This MCR was approved by Market Participants at the IGG but is awaiting CRU approval and therefore not for classification today but has been included for completeness.</p>
