<b>Reason for Request</b>

If it was possible to install Keypad Meters into Micro-Businesses this would meet the increasing demand among micro-businesses for a PAYG system. This would act as a Debt Prevention tool and would also present Suppliers with an alternative to Disconnection. Disconnection is a last step for Suppliers and can place even more strain on a Business under financial pressure.

Proposed Solution
<p>Amend the Market Procedures to allow KPMs to be installed in certain Micro-Businesses.</p> <p>It is envisaged this would be limited to single phase Meters on MCC N001.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Power NI believes that the existing single rate keypad meter population can support a commercial tariff</li> <li>• The existing Liberty version already caters for:-               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dual VAT rates (Commercial and Business)</li> <li>- Individual breakpoints of Commercial/Domestic usage split</li> <li>- Changes in emergency credit values</li> </ul>               This can be done by NIE Networks on Liberty at TCC level for commercial customers if required.             </li> <li>- Change in Friendly credit hours – This can be done by Suppliers.</li> <li>• Power NI have opened up discussions with Secure Meters to test dual VAT rates on the Liberty UAT system</li> </ul> <p>It would likely require a new UOS Tariff so would likely need to be included in a schema change.</p>
